- cam – came

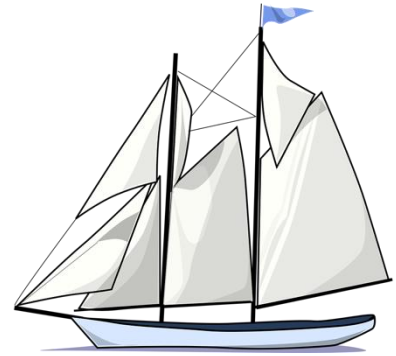
Activity 1
